Truck Bids are scheduled to go up to notice on Monday the 19th. These are sealed bids taken and accepted at the Town Hall. The new truck being looked at is projected to be up for sale next Friday. The old truck is being retired to the cemetery as a cemetery maintenance truck.

Resident Garbage Cans after the contract renewal with City Sanitation. The list of garbage cans were reviewed and amended for the proper billing for services.
